The Cultural Facilities Corporation (CFC) is a statutory enterprise of the ACT Government that manages the following major ACT cultural assets on behalf of the community :

- the Canberra Theatre Centre;
- the Canberra Museum and Gallery, including the Nolan Collection; and
- three historic places : Lanyon, Calthorpes' House and Mugga-Mugga.

In accordance with the *Cultural Facilities Corporation Act 1997*, the CFC has three advisory committees to assist it in its functions. The Advisory Committees play a significant role in the work of the CFC and make an important contribution to its functions and activities.

The committees are :

- Canberra Theatre Centre Advisory Committee;
- Canberra Museum and Gallery Advisory Committee; and
- Historic Places Advisory Committee.

The CFC is undertaking a full renewal of its Advisory Committees and is making new appointments for a three-year term. It welcomes Expressions of Interest from people who have relevant experience and expertise, and who are interested in serving as a member of one of the Advisory Committees.
